Do we want the new Chiltern Lifestyle Centre to be built or not?

You can influence that choice.

We have now reached the final decision point and this is not a choice between new and old this is between new **or nothing**.

If the new Chiltern Lifestyle Centre does not get built, there is a very strong possibility that we will lose our library, community centre, youth centre, as well as the pools, gym and The Climb as the current facilities are already past their viable life and are all likely to need to close within a relatively short time.

We now know that there is only one way to guarantee that your message of support will count and that is by posting it on the [Chiltern District Council Planning Portal](#).

So please, act now, add your message to the [Planning Portal](#). It doesn't need to be any longer than a paragraph, but it will be counted and it will begin to balance off against the objector anti-centre groups.

This is very real, without people who support the new centre doing something now, the objectors will win and the pools, the gym, the library, the youth centre and the community centre will all disappear.....the choice is as stark as that.

**What can you do**

1. Go on to the [Planning Portal](#) and lodge your message of support.
2. Ask your neighbours, friends, family to do the same....they may not realise how critical this is.
3. Get your PTA involved, many local schools use the facilities.
4. Think of any other group in the District that could be encouraged to get their individual members to register their support.
5. Print this and give it to people, they can simply **scan the QR code** to go to the Portal.

This is a numbers game....so please make sure your number is counted.

Going to the [Planning Portal](#) takes minutes, once the pools, the gym, the library, the youth centre and the community centre have gone, that is forever.
